JOB PURPOSE AND SCOPE:

EMSOU-MC provides a collaborative unit to investigate crimes of murder and manslaughter across the East Midlands region. They will also support collaborative forces with other investigations subject to tasking and capacity.

EMSOU-MC is a dynamic environment seeking to maintain public confidence by the expedient and professional response to Major Crime Investigation.

To help to deliver the Chief Constables Strategy and to demonstrate at all times the Force values. All Officers involved in carrying out functions in this role will do so in accordance with the principles of the Code of Ethics. The aim of the Code of Ethics is to support each member of the policing profession to deliver the highest professional standards in their service to the public.

CORE WORK AREAS:

1. To form part of a dedicated team of officers who provide specialist support in the investigation of Major Crime.
2. To carry out effective and efficient enquiries into cases of Murder, Manslaughter and any other relevant investigations as determined by the Regional Tasking Process and Senior Investigating officers.
3. To gather intelligence and evidence relating to persons involved in crime, as described above, and to facilitate their arrest and prosecution.
4. To provide a quality of service to the people of Lincolnshire and the East Midlands region that ensures fair and equal treatment for all and be available for deployment anywhere within the East Midlands region, at the discretion of the Detective Chief Inspector (EMSOU- MC).
5. This is an excellent opportunity to work on high profile investigations. You will work closely with partner agencies with the aim of bringing offenders to justice. The role will enable the successful candidate to gain experience in all aspects of file preparation and case building.
